Sunday 1st* October Abbey Wood, Kent. Director: Jerry Hooker

This is a rare opportunity for TRG members to see and wet sieve the early Eocene Blackheath Fm. shell bed. PLEASE CONTACT ME TO BOOK A PLACE. [Not the 3rd as previously stated]

- Attendance requires all participants to retain and sort all material over 0.5mm. Participants may keep all they find, with the exception of reptile, bird and mammal remains, which should be brought to the Director's attention. Please bring a digging tool, a large bucket or bowl, bags and your own set of graded sieves. Water for wet sieving and a few sieves should be available. If you need to borrow a 0.5mm sieve, please email the Secretary, in advance, because their numbers are limited.
- Meet at 12 noon. (NOT BEFORE PLEASE!) at the excavation within the woods. We are normally required to be out of the enclosure by 5pm. Abbey Wood station is within walking distance. Drivers please park on Abbey Road (the B213), not in the woods.
- As previously, we must hire a mechanical digger. This is a costly undertaking, so it is hoped that all active participants will make an appropriate donation, in the order of £25 (Members) and £30 (Guests). Without this voluntary donation we would not be able to afford this excavation.
- Participants must be aware that there is no guarantee that we will be able to find and excavate the shell bed.
